Established in 1996, Big Eagle services the oil and gas industry with its fleet of HydroVacs, Vacuum Trucks, Water Trucks, Steam Trucks, and Nitrogen services. It provides the following services to their clients:

Big Eagle's head office is in Camrose with other locations across British Columbia, Alberta, and Saskatchewan. The local office (located in Redcliff) employs over 160 people.



Types & Nature of Work

The majority of employment opportunities at Big Eagle involve driving and/or operating heavy equipment in one or more of the following services:

- Nitrogen transport.
- Vacuum trucks.
- HydroVac.
- Water trucks.
- Steam trucks.
- Pressure testers.
- Coil tubing.

Some responsibilities of drivers include:

- Transporting fluid to a specified location.
- Maintaining logbooks.
- Daily equipment maintenance.
- Filling out forms and billing.
- Reporting hazards, incidents, and accidents to appropriate staff.



Other employment opportunities also exist for:

- Mechanics (and apprentices) responsible for performing mechanical maintenance duties on trucks, trailers, equipment, and vehicles.
- Welders (and apprentices) responsible for performing welding maintenance duties on trucks, trailers, equipment, and vehicles.
- Wash Bay Attendants responsible for cleaning trucks, trailers, equipment, and vehicles and monitoring the shop and yard.
- Shop Assistants responsible for maintenance duties on trucks, trailers, equipment, and vehicles, assisting mechanics, monitoring shop, yard, and parking areas, and operating yard truck as necessary.



Ideal Candidate Qualifications

- 3 years licensed Class 1A/3A driving experience.
- 25 years of age.
- Physically fit, good health.
- Drivers abstract (with less than 3 demerit points).
- Responsible.
- Positive and professional attitude.
- Capable of handling all situations calmly.

Ideally, applicants will have their H₂S Alive, CPR, and First Aid certificates at the time of application.

Training Opportunities

Big Eagle employees are provided in-house safety and construction training as well as on-the-job training. This includes:

- Staff orientations.
- Safe work procedures.
- Hazard recognition and assessment.
- Safe driving policies.
- Safety equipment.
- Incident and accident reporting.

Employees working in the field or arriving on a new job participate in tailgate safety meetings and fill out pre-job inspection forms. Surprise site inspections are also done to verify safe-work practices and job site safety procedures.

Other certificates employees are required to obtain include:

- Petroleum Safety Training (PST)
- Construction Safety Training (CSTS)
- WHMIS
- TDG
- Confined Space
- Hours of Service (HOS)
- GODI

Hours, Pay, Benefits

Most employees work fulltime. There may be some part time positions available. Shift work is required on evenings, nights, weekends, and holidays when needed. Overtime may be available.

Employees are provided a benefit package after successfully completing a three-month probationary period.

How to Apply

Applicants can apply in person, or by mail, fax, or email with a resume and current driver's abstract.

Before drivers are hired, they are required to go through a practical driver's evaluation, followed by a personal interview.
