Types & Nature of Work

There are several different entry-level positions available within Classic Communities. Advancement to higher-level jobs is based on additional training, good work ethic and experience.

1. Cabinet Installers

- Building & installing custom and stock cabinetry into new homes.
- Ability to take accurate measurements, miter moldings, make on-site repairs and lift up to 35 kgs.

2. General Labourers

- Responsibilities could be assigned in any area of the company.
- Ability to work in a team environment.
- Ability to take direction and perform a variety of duties as required.

3. Trades Personnel

- Positions may be available in various areas including:
 - Drywallers (Boarders)
 - Tapers
 - Framers
 - Finishers
 - Painters
 - Other trades

4. Site Clean Up Personnel

- Responsible for cleaning up the job site after trades people.
- Responsible for overall clean up of the home after all work is complete and before clients view the home, including vacuuming, washing walls, dusting, etc.

- Possess good customer service skills.
- Ability to pay attention to detail.
- Provide high quality work.
- Strong initiative and follow up skills.
- Ability to work independently but within a team.

Training Opportunities

Training opportunities are dependent upon the position. Orientation and some on-the-job training are available with all positions.

First Aid, CPR, and on-site job safety training is provided. On-going safety training is also provided.

Hours, Pay, Benefits

Employment is generally full time or part time and year round.

Hours of operation are regular business hours Monday through Friday, from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. Regular overtime is available.

A benefits package is available to all full time workers after a probationary period.

Training incentives for continued advancements are available.
