Company Background

Green Power Ltd. is an agricultural equipment dealer specializing in full-line John Deere agriculture and Commercial & Consumer equipment. Founded in 1935, Green Power is the oldest single family-owned John Deere dealership in North America.

The company specializes in all types of agricultural equipment to meet the diverse needs of farmers in southeast Alberta. This includes tractors, tillage, seeding, hay, forage, and harvesting equipment. It also sells lawn and garden equipment and novelty items such as clothing, toys, and collectibles.

Green Power also services and sells parts for all makes and models of agricultural equipment.

The company has dealerships in Medicine Hat, Burdett, and Taber. It has 21 employees in Medicine Hat, 16 in Burdett, and 25 in the Taber dealership.



Types & Nature of Work

Green Power has three employment areas: Sales Representatives, Equipment Technicians, and Parts Personnel.

Sales Representatives

- Promote equipment sales to new and existing customers.
- Recommend appropriate equipment and products to meet customer needs.

Equipment Technicians

- Repair, overhaul, and look after equipment including tractors, tillage, seeding, hay, forage, and harvesting equipment.
- This can be an entry-level position.

Parts Personnel

- Keep track of supplies and parts inventory.
- Order, receive, sort, price, and sell parts.
- This can be an entry-level position.

Ideal Candidate Qualifications

The ideal Sales Representative should be:

- Self-motivated.
- Willing to talk to and understand customers.
- Willing to learn how equipment works and is operated.
- Able to demonstrate how equipment works.
- Computer skills and working with numbers is an asset.





Ideal Candidate Qualifications

(cont'd)

The ideal Equipment Technician and/or Parts Personnel should:

- Have a Grade 12 diploma.
- Have an interest in mechanics.
- Have a valid driver's license.
- Be willing to follow all safety measures.

Training Opportunities

Green Power offers various on-the-job training opportunities. After a three-month probationary period, Equipment Technicians and Parts Personnel can apply for an apprenticeship program.

Equipment Technicians can also be certified through the John Deere Agricultural Technician Apprenticeship program at Olds College. Being certified gives employees the added skills and education to advance within a John Deere dealership.

Ongoing on-the-job factory training is also offered for all employees. Training incentives may be available.

Hours, Pay, Benefits

Employees work year-round and fulltime. Occasional overtime may be available. There is generally no shift work. However, employees may be required to be on-call during peak seasons. The hours of operations are normally 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 pm weekdays and 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Saturdays.

Employees will receive a benefits package after successfully completing a three-month probationary period.

How to Apply

Applicants can apply in person with a resume. Their resume can also be faxed, emailed, or mailed.

Resumes are reviewed and assessed. Applicants may be contacted right away to answer a few questions. References are then checked and a formal interview will be scheduled.

A Driver's Abstract may also be requested if applicable.
